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Dear Azure Class,

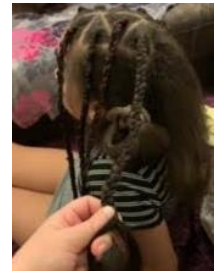
How are you all? I am missing you all and I hope you are keeping safe and well!
