First

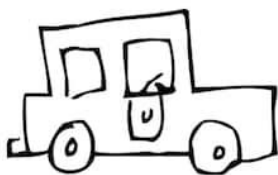
Have a look in your toy box and choose one of your favourite toy that you want to make a model of. It could be anything like a car, a train, a teddy or any other toy of your choice.



Next

For example, if you want to draw a plan of a car - what shape will you need to draw for the body of the car? How many wheels would you need to draw and what shapes will they be?
