Have a great week and please do share photos of your wonderful 3D models!


First

First get an empty cereal box.

Carefully open the cardboard box, so it is nice and flat.

Draw an outline of a mosque on half of the cereal box, try and make it as big as you can.





Next

Carefully using a pair of scissors cut it out.

Use the mosque you have drawn to trace the mosque on the other half of the cereal box and cut it out.

Make a cut on the centre of the mosque dome, one cut on the top and the another cut at the bottom, try and make the lengths the same.

Then

Decorate your mosque- be as creative as you can!

Finally fit the two cuts you made earlier onto each other to create a 3D effect and there you have it your very own 3D mosque!
