

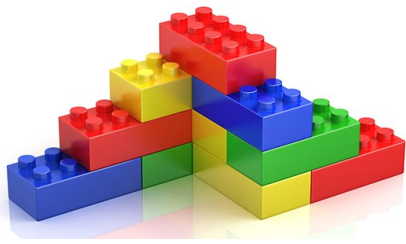


# Learning through play



When we return to school, your teacher will give you a chance to share what you have done with your class.

## Build something



Make something with lego, blocks or other building materials. Ask children to draw a picture of it and then write a sentence.

## Junk Modelling

Children to use old boxes and other recyclable materials to make something of interest. Can they draw and plan what they are going to make and then collect the resources and build it.



## Boardgames

Play boardgames as a family. Dust off old boardgames and teach the children how to play.

Make your own boardgame and set of rules.

## Den making

Use sheets, duvets, pillows, your imagination to design and create dens in your home. Create a perfect reading den.



## Cooking

Cook with the family. Can you make a traditional family dish? Fairy cakes? Help cook dinner. Can you write a list of ingredients? Can the children write the instructions on how to make it?

## Role Play

Children to dress up and act out roles from their experiences or fairy tales. Dress up in parents old clothes, ties, dresses etc. Children to act out family roles. Dress up in traditional clothing and role play parties and festivals.



## Reading

Read your favourite stories as a family. Talk about what happens, who are the characters, who is your favourite character and why? Make puppets of the characters and retell the story. Put on a puppet show.

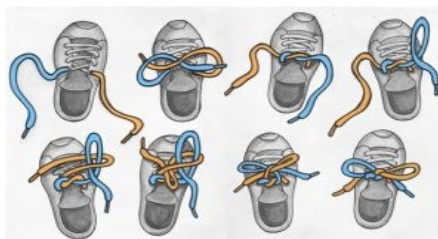
## Yoga

Teach children how to dress independently—how fast can they get dressed? Teach children how to fasten their buttons and tie their laces.



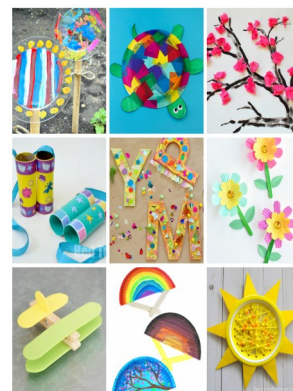
## Painting and Drawing

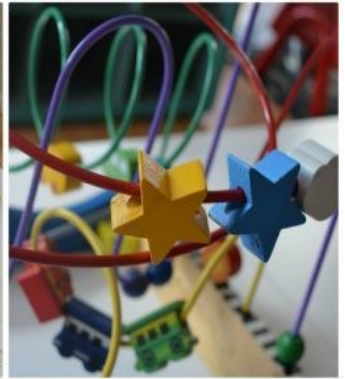
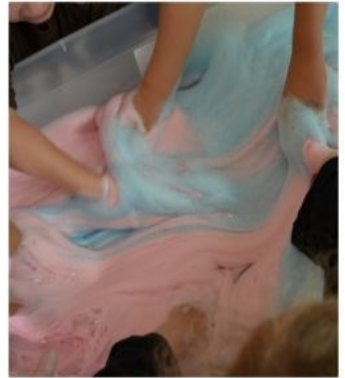
