The day begins early for people in villages in Africa. People in the villages live in huts made from mud with grass roofs. The women get up before the sun rises. The women head out to the fields to plant crops. At lunchtime they return home with firewood and fruit. Then they wash their clothes and prepare the evening meal.

The men check their fishing nets in rivers or lakes. They take their cattle to the fields to plough the ground. If they catch any fish they string them together and carry them home for dinner.

Children get up early to go to school. When the children get home from school they collect water from the well or river.

In the evening, families talk around the fire. They go to bed early and get ready for the next day.

Wonderful Water


