

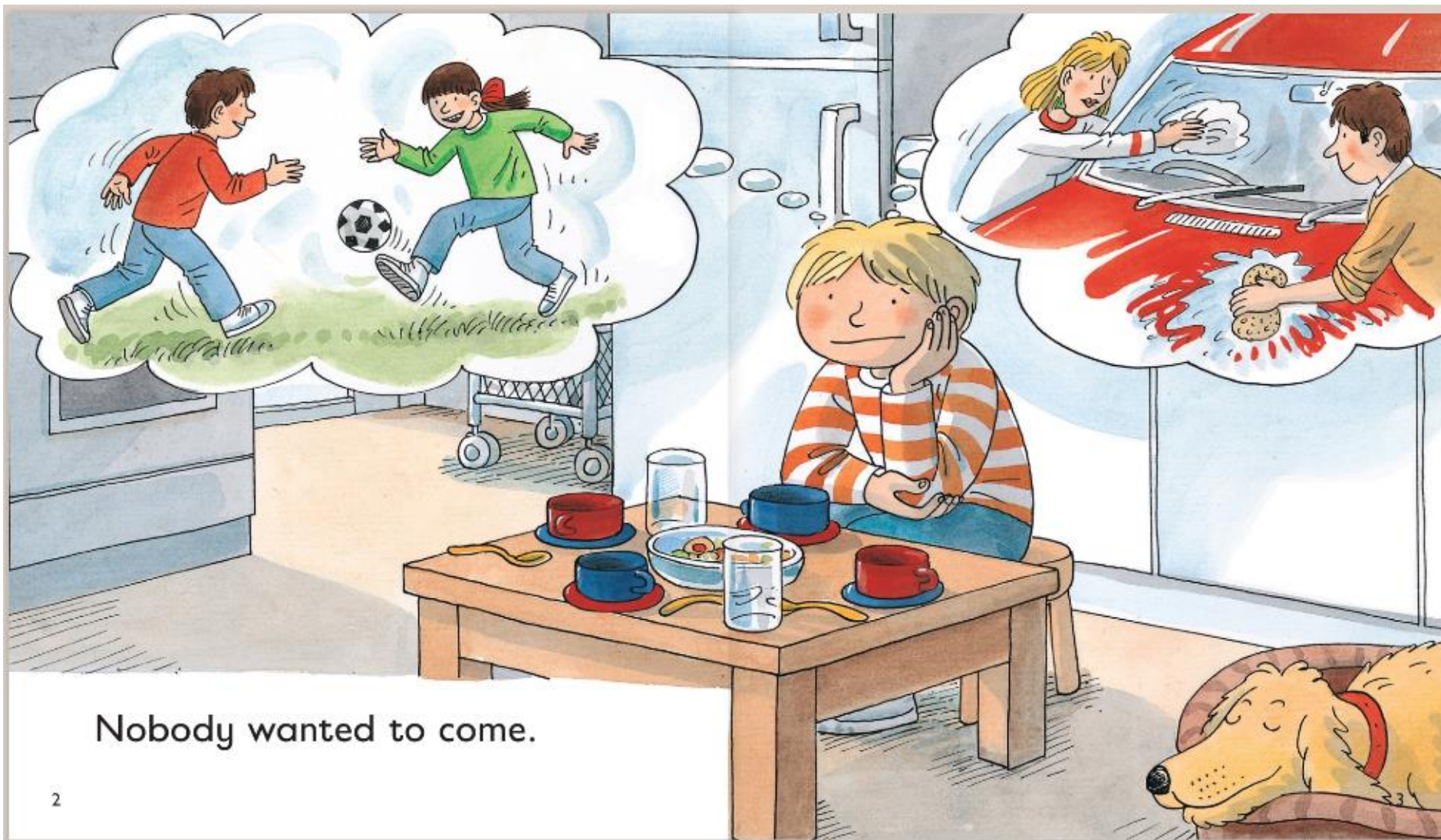

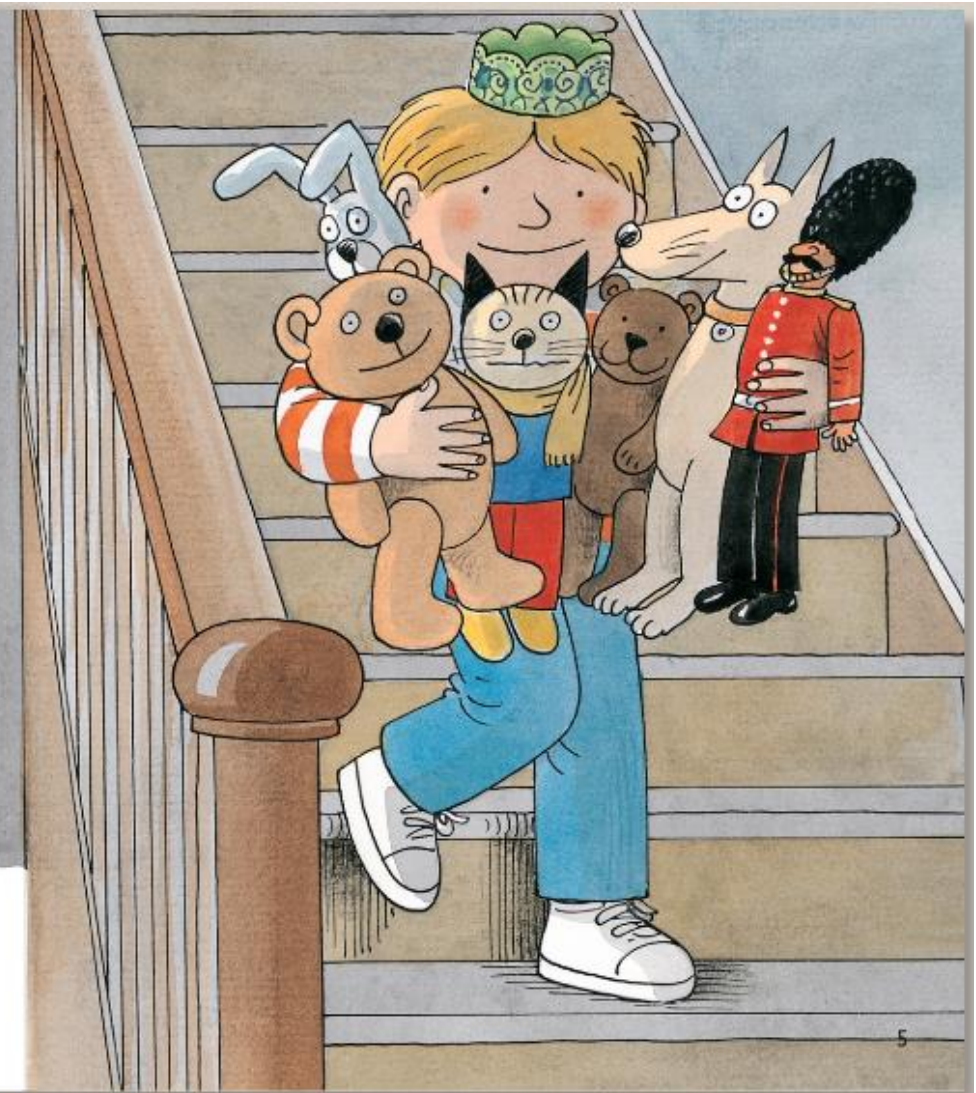
Kipper wanted a party.

He got his toys.



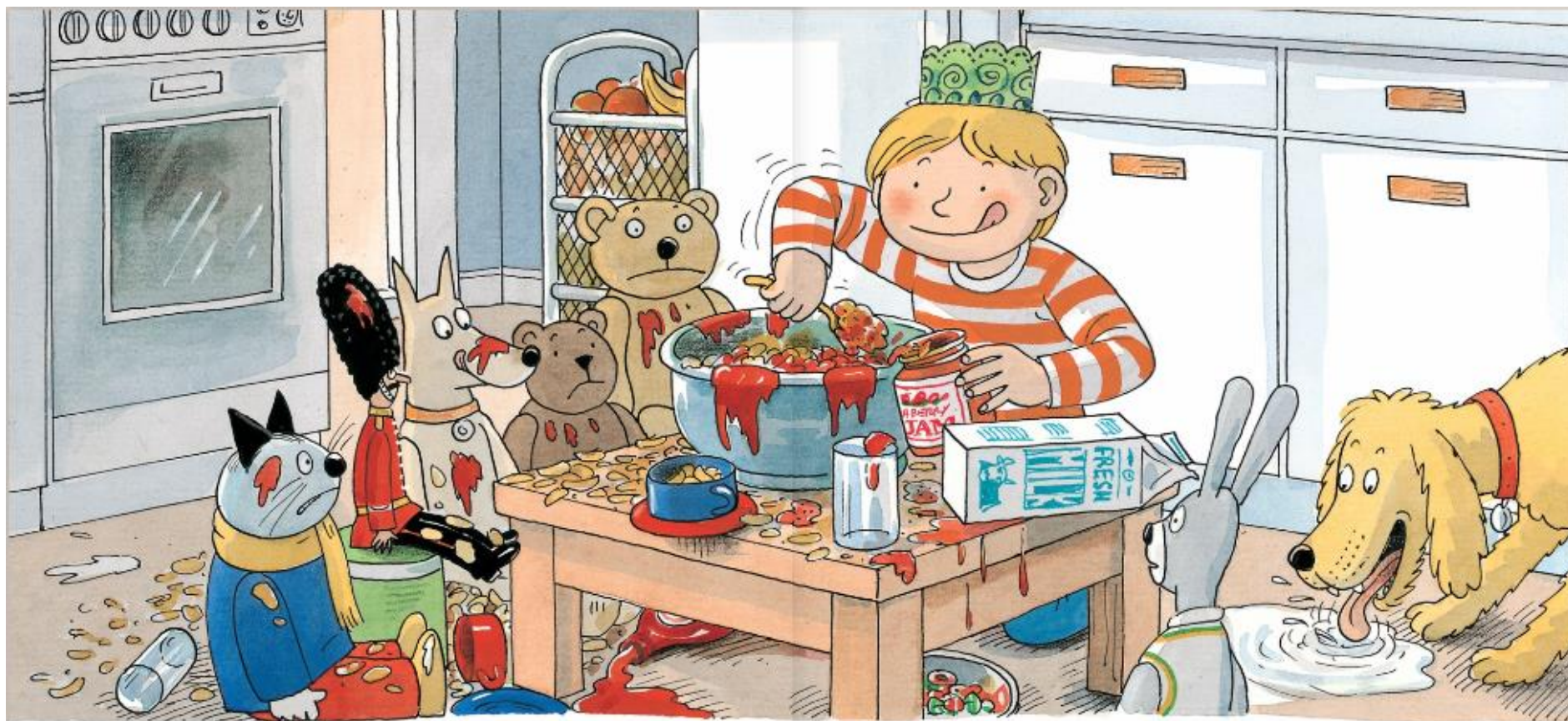


He wanted a cake.



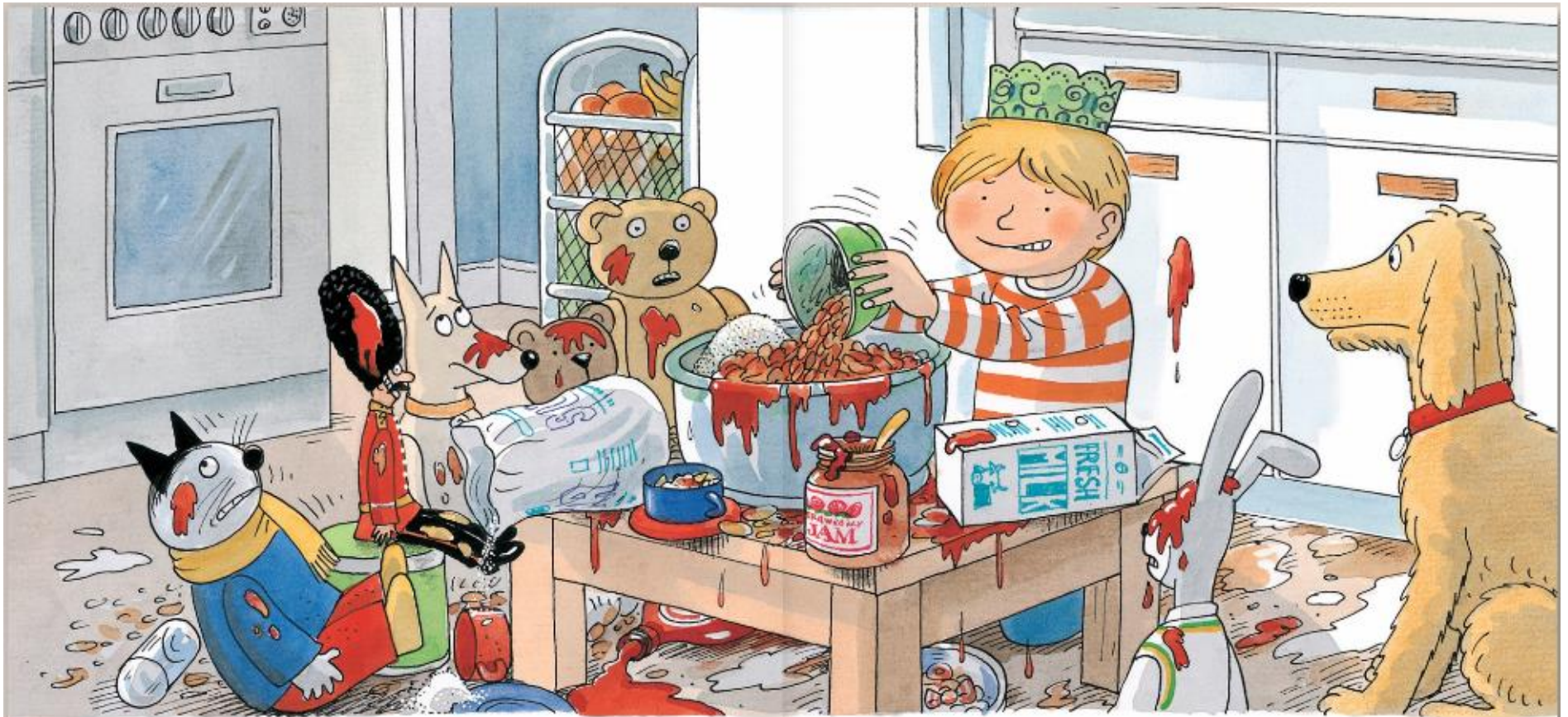
He put in cornflakes.

He put in tomato sauce.



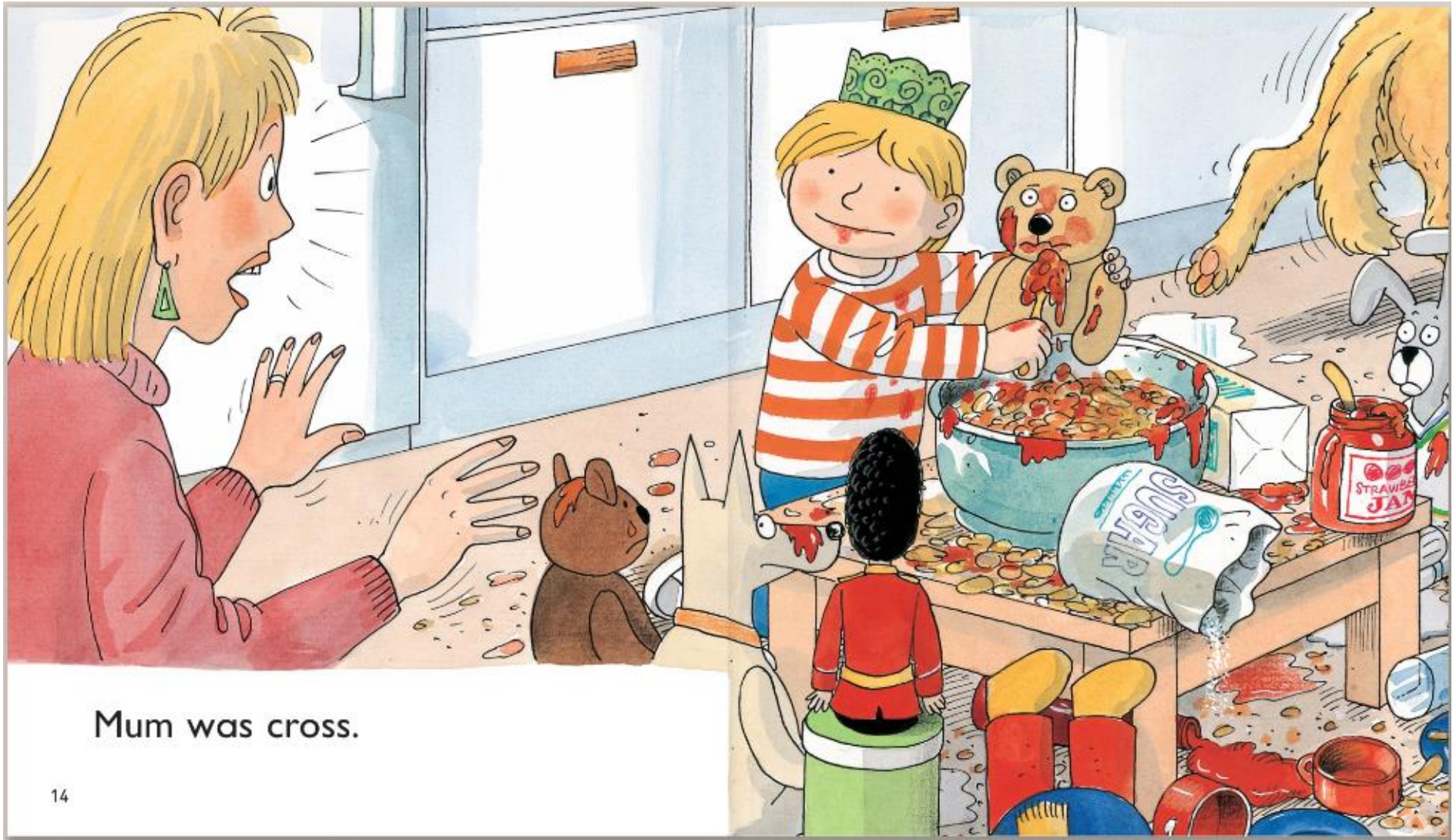
He put in milk.
