

Home learning for children who are self isolating

What to expect if your child is unable to attend school because they are self isolating

Possible scenarios

Your child is self isolating and absent from school because:

- Your child has been told to by their GP they are clinically extremely vulnerable
- Someone at home is confirmed as having Covid-19 or showing symptoms and waiting for test results.
- Your child is confirmed as having Covid-19 or showing symptoms and waiting for test results.

If your child is absent, please contact the school office to inform us.

If the absence is because your child has to self isolate, they are expected to learn from home.



For the initial absence, learning is already available on your child's Google Classroom space entitled '*learning for those isolating*'.



You will receive a phone call from an adult within your child's year group team to explain the learning that they will be able to access from Google Classroom.

This learning will be similar to the learning the children are doing in the classroom and will include daily maths, English and other subjects.

We hope this supports the progress of their learning and helps them feel more comfortable when they return to school.
