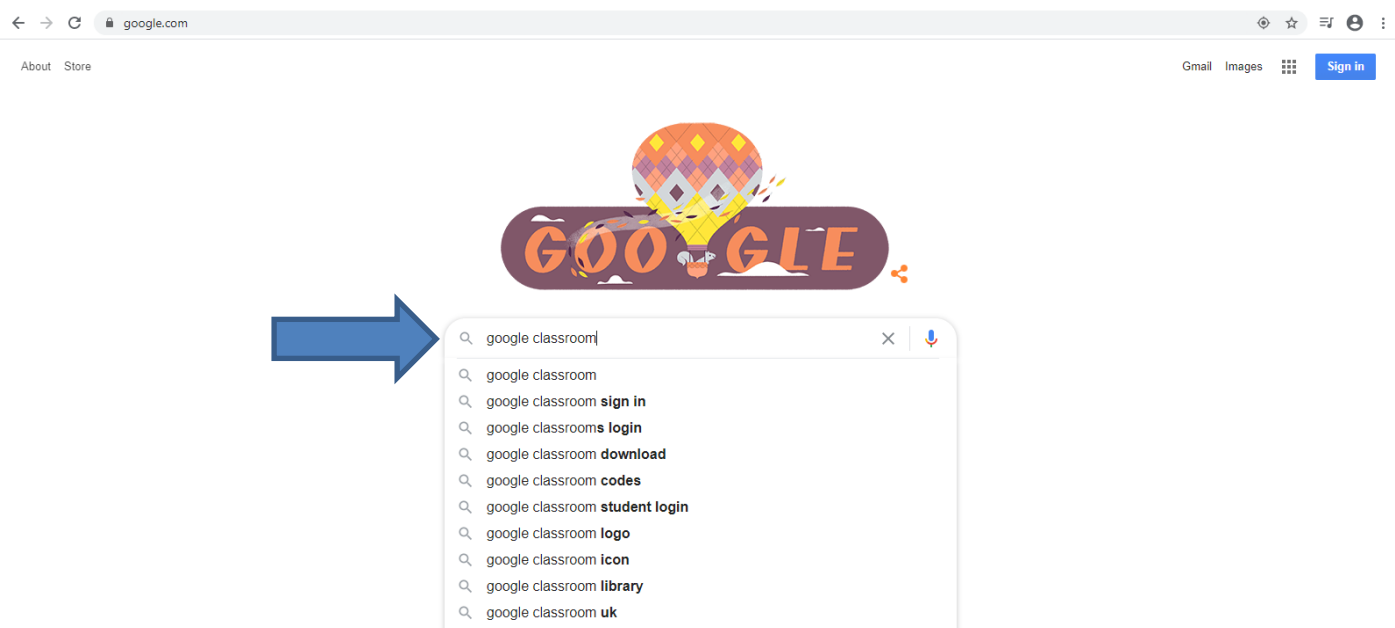


Dear Parents/Carers,

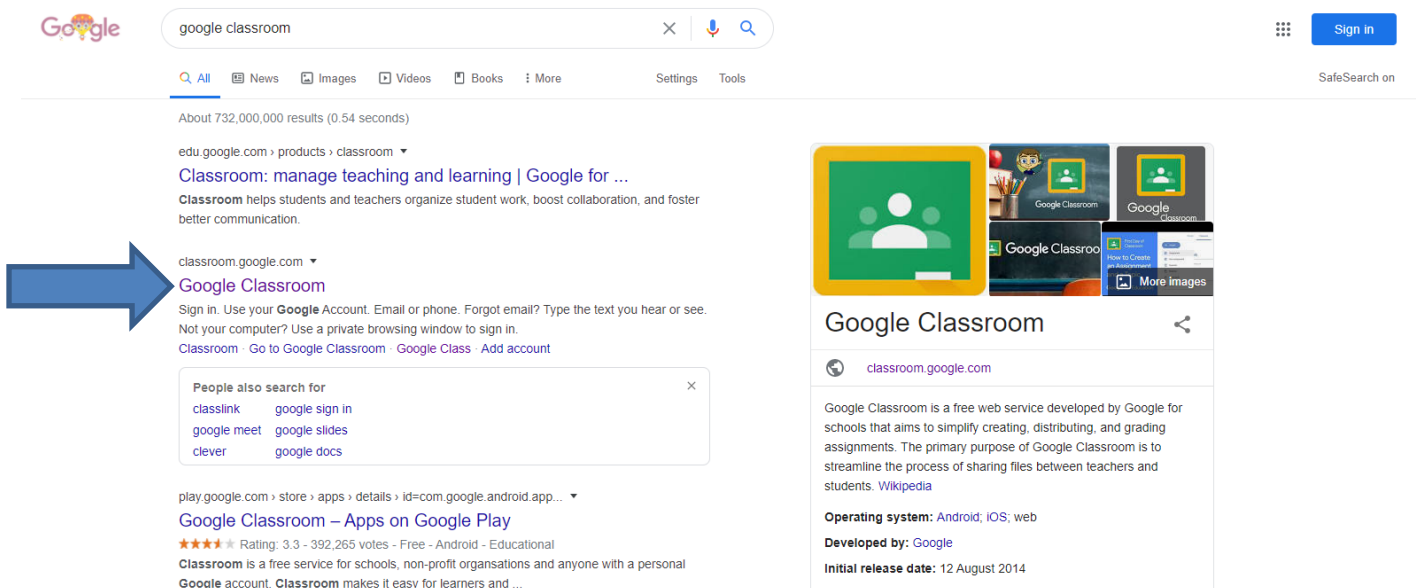
Ben Jonson are now using Google Classroom to set learning for your children. This might be learning your child completes in class or it might be homework. Homework will be set every week on Google Classroom. Google Classroom should work on any laptop, tablet or modern smartphone. In order that you can support your children with their Google Classroom learning, we have created this parent's guide.

PART 1 – Getting onto Google Classroom

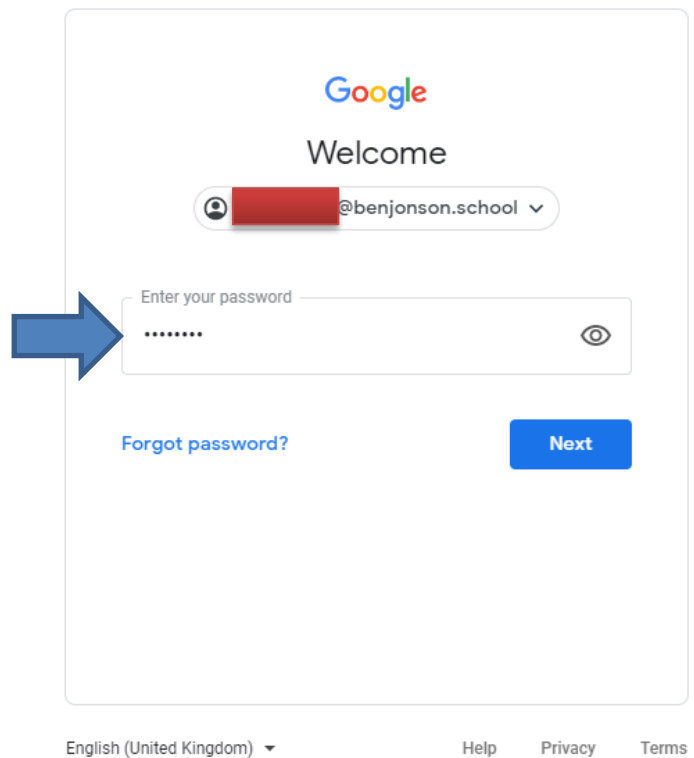
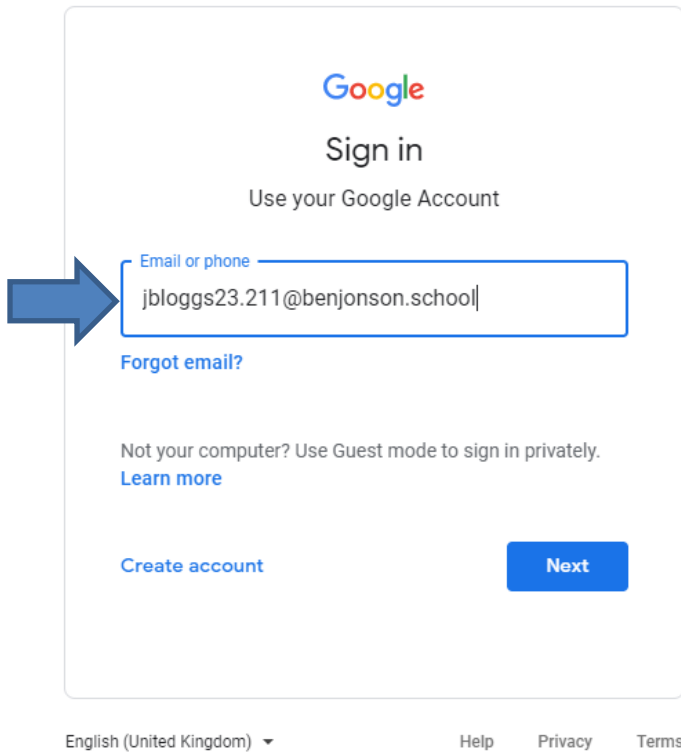
Step 1 – Open up a web browser (such as Google) and type “Google Classroom” into the search bar



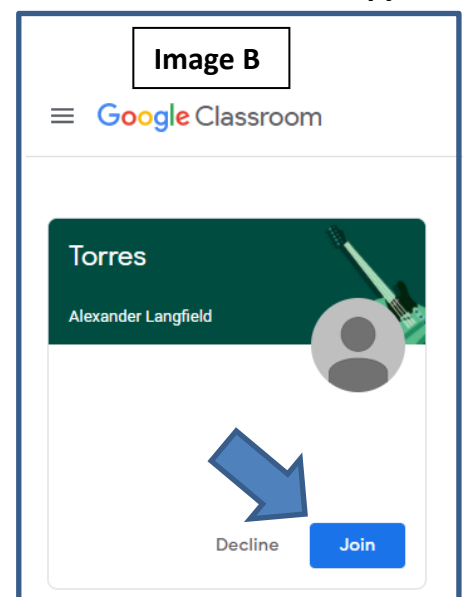
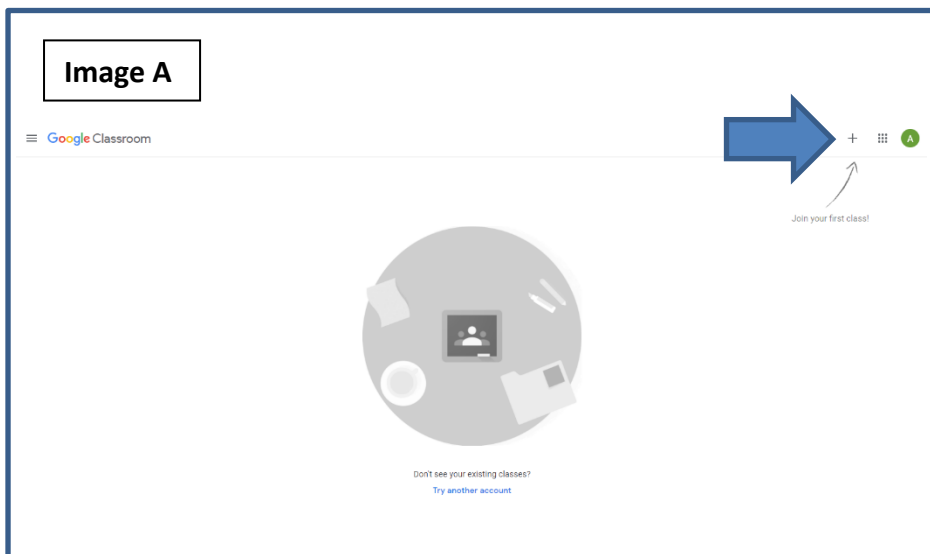
Step 2 – Open Google Classroom by clicking on the link that appears entitled “Google Classroom”



Step 3 – Sign in using the school email address and password that has been given to your child. Note that this is different to the “class code”, which we will come to later.





Step 4 – The first time your child logs in they will need to select they are a student. Once they get to the home page, they need to join a class. If they have not been invited into a class by their teacher they will need to click the + key in the top right (see image A). If a teacher has invited them into a class, they just need to click “Join” (see image B).



Step 5 – If your child has not been invited into a class they will have been given a “class code” by their teacher. To join the class, they need to input this code. Once they have joined, they won’t need this code again. Enter the code and click “Join”.

Step 6 – Once in the class, your child will be taken to the “Stream” page. This shows messages and activity in the class, as well as any upcoming learning assignments. You are now ready for PART 2 – Using Google Classroom.

The “Stream” page is the class homepage.

The “Classwork” page is where your child’s learning assignments will be.

The “People” page is where your child can see the names of teachers and children in the class.
