

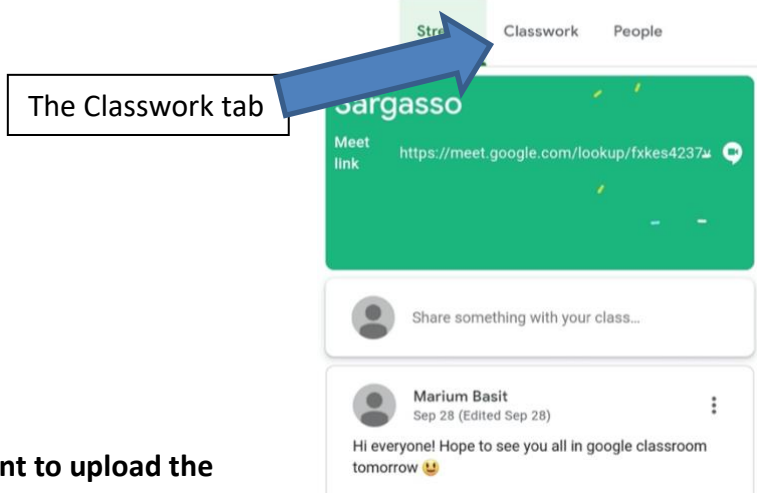
Dear parents/carers

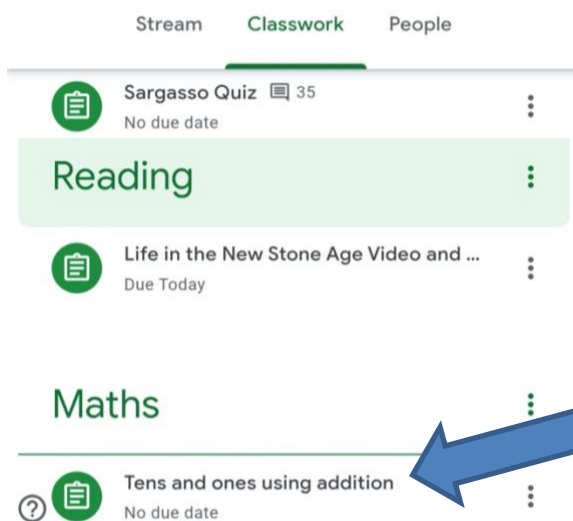
## PART 4 – Submitting learning and uploading pictures

On Google Classroom, sometimes the learning task set by the teacher will involve your child writing something at home. In order for teachers to see the final outcome, we will often ask your child to take a photo of it and upload it on Google Classroom.

Step 1 – Click on the “Classwork” tab on the main page.




Step 2 – Click on the assignment that you want to upload the picture to.



Let's say your child has completed their maths learning on 'Tens and ones using addition'. They've done this on paper. They not need to open up that assignment.



**Step 3 – A summary of the assignment will open up showing instructions and the files involved. Click on 'View assignment'.**






To upload a file or photo, click 'Add or create'

**Step 5 – Once your child clicks 'Add or create' a menu will appear. If you want to attach or take a photo of the learning or if you want to attach a document, click 'File'.**

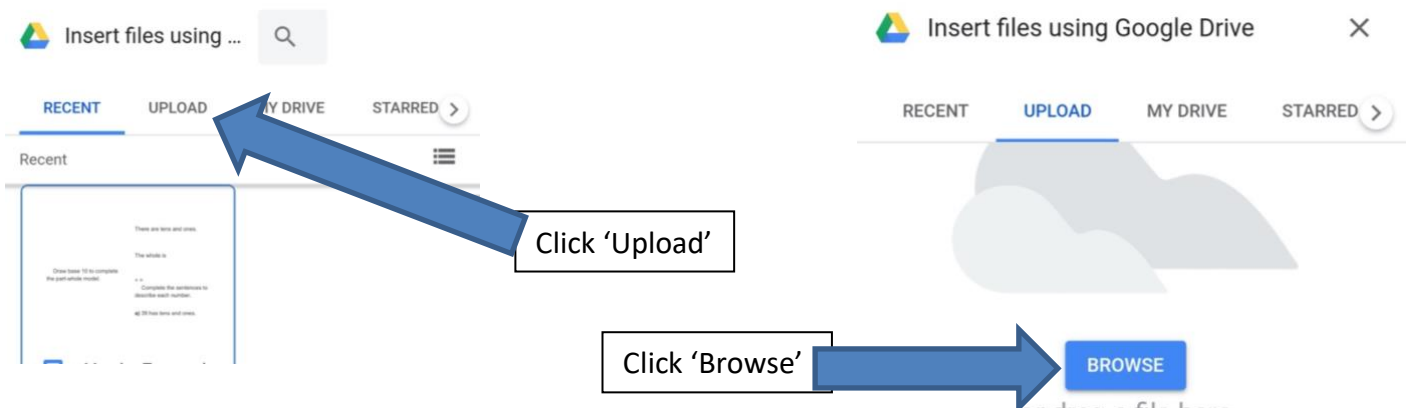

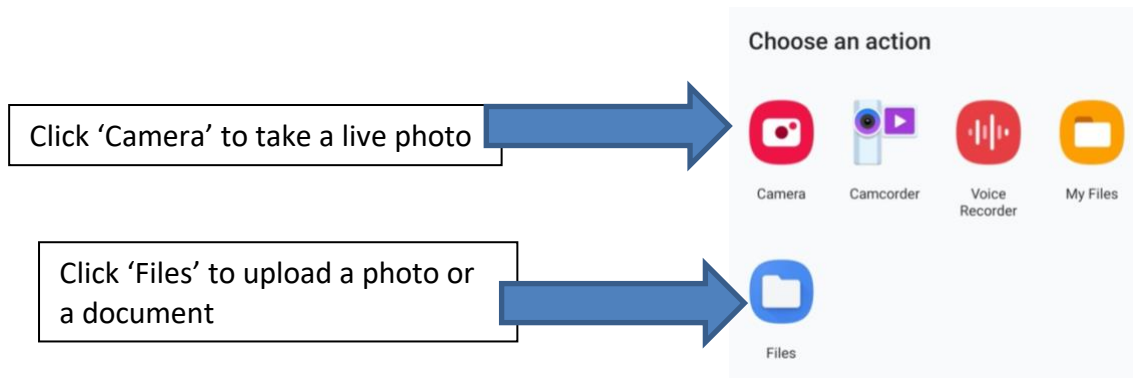

## Step 7 – To take a live photo of the learning, click 'Camera'. If you've already taken the photo and it is on your computer, tablet or phone, or if you are uploading a different kind of document click 'File'.



## Step 8 – If using the 'Camera' function, take a photo of your work.

Step 9 – Your file's name will appear in the 'Your work' section. If you need to upload more images or files, go back to Step 4 and click 'Add or create'. If your child is ready to submit their learning, they just need to click 'Turn in'.
